

Test and Go

(for Non-Thai Nationals)

(registration starts from 1 Feb 2022)

PRE DEPARTURE

REQUIREMENTS

- 1) **Eligible countries / territories**
 - All countries / territories
 - 2) **Vaccination**
 - Fully vaccinated with a vaccine approved by Thailand or WHO no less than 14 days before departure
 - Recovered persons with 1 dose of vaccination (received after infection) must provide medical certificate showing full recovery
 - Aged below 18 not required to be fully vaccinated (must register on Thailand Pass and travel alongside parents/legal guardian)

- 3) **Insurance with minimum coverage of 50,000 USD for medical expenses** (expats residing in Thailand can use social security card or certifying letter issued by employer)
 - 4) **Fully paid SHA Extra+ / AQ hotel reservation confirmation for day 1 and day 5**
 - on day 1, first RT-PCR test and airport transfer
 - on day 5, second RT-PCR test (could be a different hotel)

1. REGISTER ON THAILAND PASS

(you are advised to register at least 7 days before your departure date)

Documents Required for Registration

- 1) Passport
- 2) Vaccination Certificate (travellers with EU DCC can use 2/2 vaccine certificate as proof of both the 1st and 2nd doses)
- 3) Insurance with minimum coverage of 50,000 USD for medical expenses
- 4) Fully paid SHA Extra+ / AQ hotel reservation (day 1 and day 5 with 2 RT-PCR tests and airport transfer), could be a different hotel
- 5) Thai visa (if required)

* Medical certificate showing full recovery (for recovered persons who received only 1 dose of vaccination after infection)

2. GET A COVID TEST

Negative RT-PCR test result no more than 72 hours prior to departure
OR

In case of positive RT-PCR result, must have a medical certificate stating that you have recovered from COVID-19

(infected more than 14 days but not more than 3 months)

Aged 6 and below not required (must travel with parents)



3. DO 1st RT-PCR TEST

Day of arrival (day 1)

- Undergo 1st RT-PCR test at the hotel or designated venue and wait for the result in the hotel room
- If the result is negative, you are allowed to travel anywhere in Thailand and undergo 2nd RT-PCR test on day 5

ARRIVAL IN THAILAND

4. DO 2nd RT-PCR TEST

5th Day of arrival (day 5)

- Undergo 2nd RT-PCR test at the hotel or designated venue and wait for the result in the hotel room
- If 2nd test result is negative, you are allowed to travel anywhere in Thailand

DURING STAY IN THAILAND
